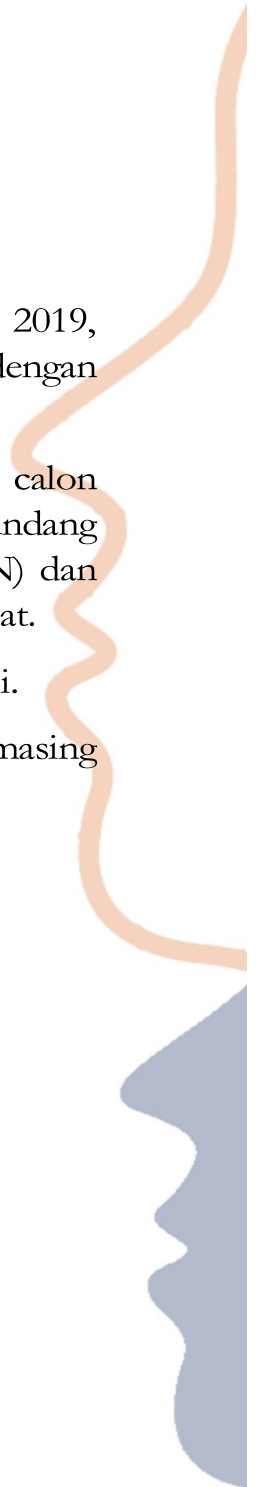
The **Anti** - Corruption Debate

Mr. Widjojanto is the founder of Indonesian Corruption Watch (ICW) and the co-founder of KONTRAS. The Indonesian human right activist was the Vice Chairman of KPK from 2011 to 2015. He holds a Master degree and doctorate in Law from Padjajaran University.

Rio Yovian Haminoto

Tamalia Alisjahbana is a consultant for the Jakarta Endowment for Arts and Heritage, former member of the National Team of Heritage Experts at the Indonesia Ministry of Education and Culture. She was the first Indonesian woman to be educated at the University of Cambridge.

Prior to opening his eponymous corporate finance firm, he was the President Director of the Indonesian Recovery Fund Limited and Director of CCA Holdings Limited.
